Mary Williams Smith received her formal education in the Aurora School System.

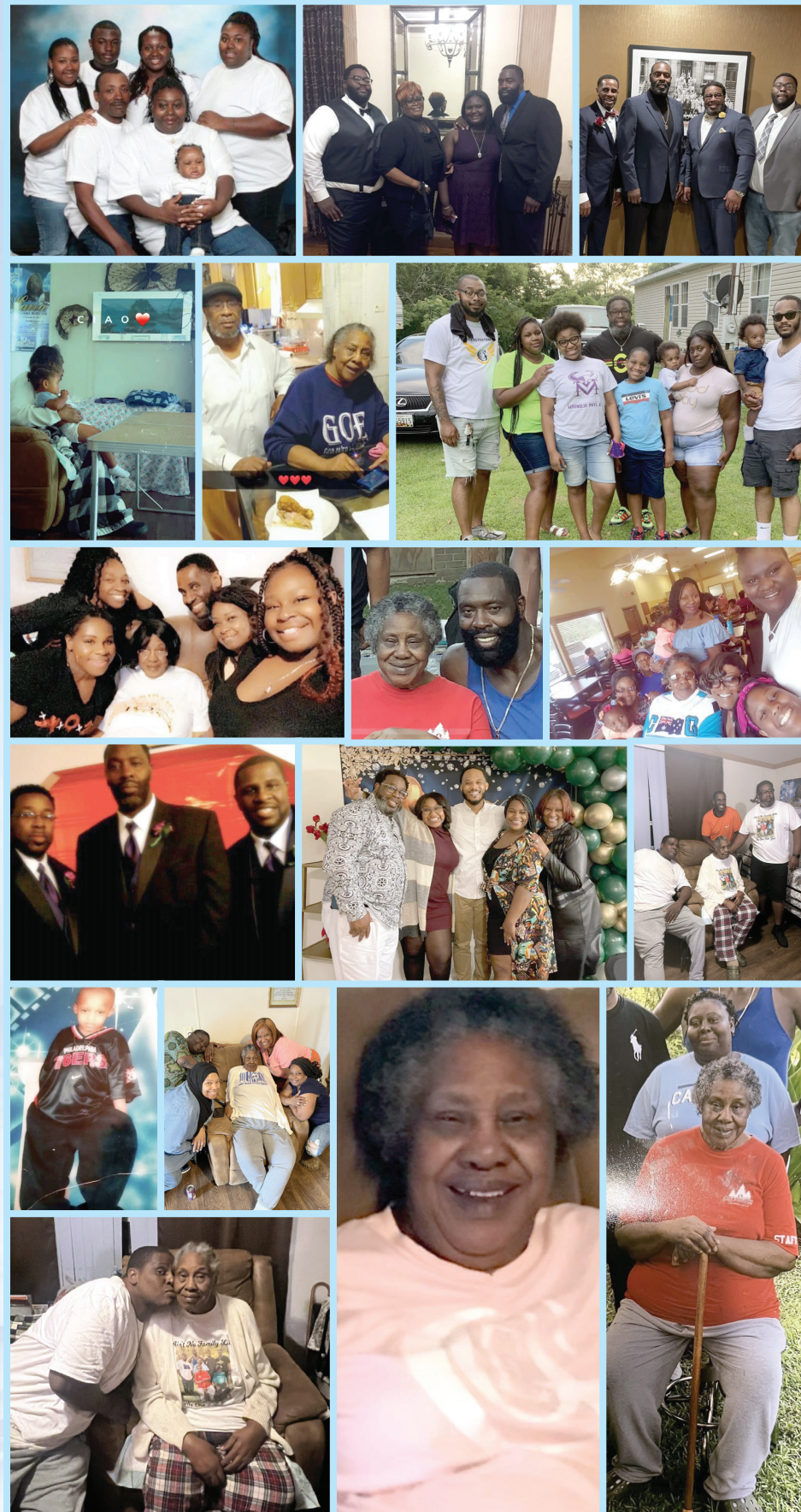
