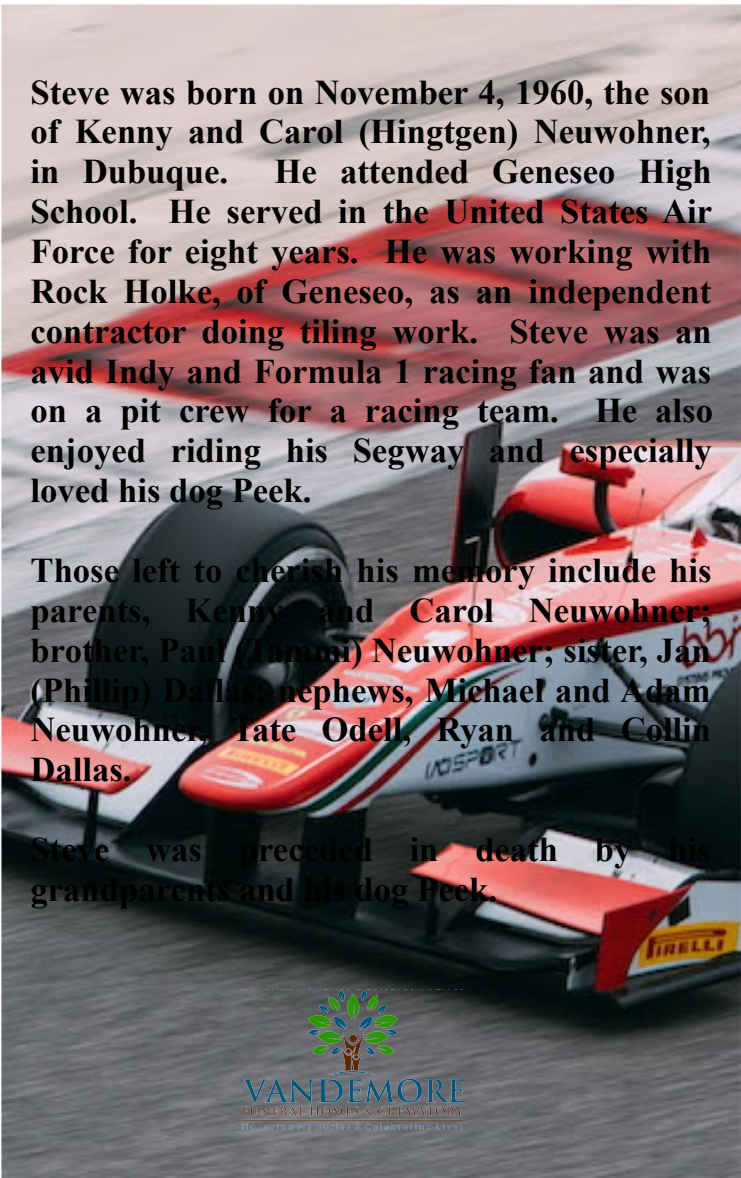

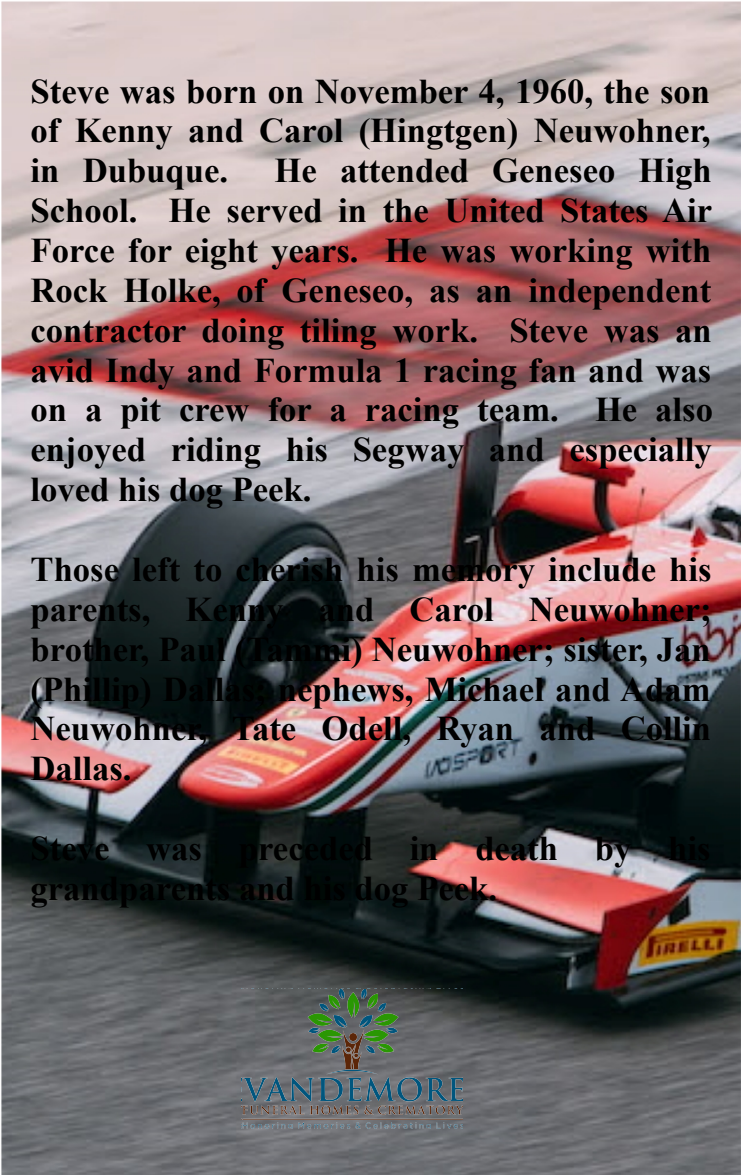
Steve was preceded in death by his grandparents and his dog Peek.
