She was preceded in death by her parents Harry and Helen; husbands, DeVon and Virgil; sister, Joy Sundeen; and brother, Carl Cochran.

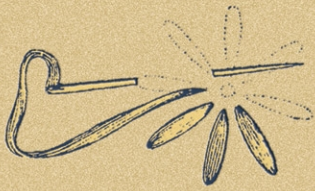
