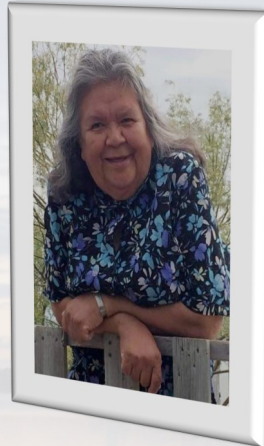

Who is Now In Heaven***

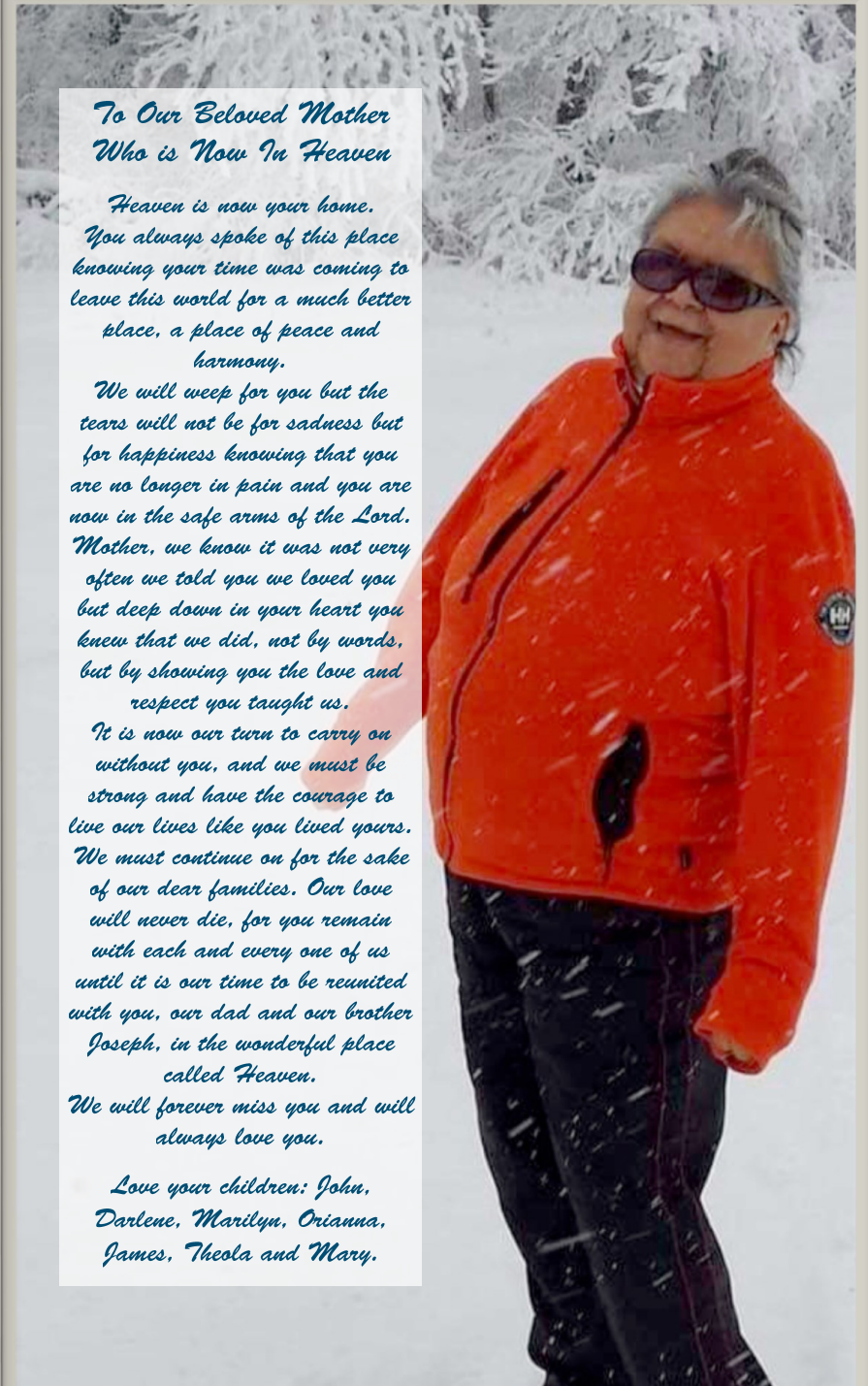
*Heaven is now your home.
