You are always at our side.*

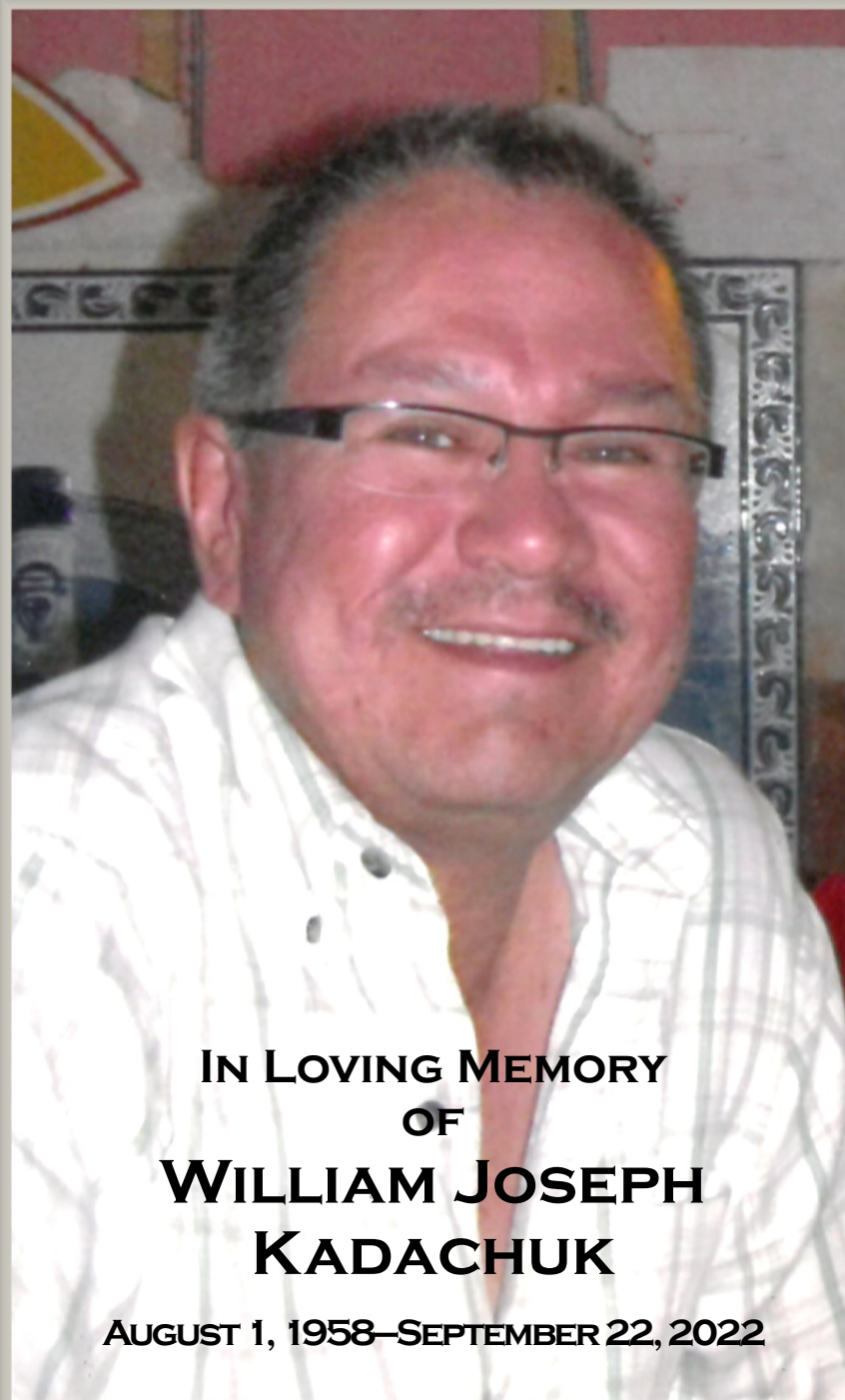

Dad was born Friday, August 1st, 1958 at The Pas, Manitoba. William and also known as Sonny or Bill, was the eldest son of Rose and William Kadachuk. Shortly after he was born, they moved to Thompson and moved back in 1970. Dad loved to go visit family in Cumberland House. He loved to hang out with his close cousin Bonnie Kadachuk. Dad was a loving husband to Darlene Kadachuk and a very caring

father to Darryl, Michelle, Denise, Whitney and Jade. He loved all his grandchildren and was very proud of them.

Dad was united in marriage to our Mom, Darlene Head on June 24, 1983. Shortly after their marriage they moved to Bracken Dam. This is where mom and dad created so many great memories for us; fishing, snowmobiling, sliding, playing on our tire swing dad made us, skating on the river and the treehouse dad had made for us. We could not have asked for a better place to grow up.

Dad received schooling in Thompson and then moved to The Pas and attended MBCI. He then attended KCC to get his Grade 12 GED and furthered his education graduating from Heavy Duty Mechanic's also at KCC. Dad began working at Gil's Marine until 1988 and applied for a position at PBDC where he worked for almost 30 years until his illness started and he went on disability.

Even though Bill was working at PBDC he continued to further his education and received his Certificate in Computer Applications in June 1992 (KCC), Certificate in the Management of Community, Economic and Organization Development in May 1994 (University of Manitoba), Certificate in Business Administration in April 1997 (Brandon University), Management Certificate Program, June 2001 (University of Winnipeg) and finally in June 2019 he received his Diploma in Ininiw Nekani Human Resource Management from University College of the North.

Dad loved to watch our mom play baseball in their earlier years, which then lead to him watching his daughters play. Dad used to play hockey in his younger years, where he coached his daughters and wife for a while. He then watched his grandchildren play hockey and would pay them for every goal they scored; he was their biggest supporter. Dad also used to love to fix up skidoo's and race them. When dad got older, he enjoyed watching the Winnipeg Jets and the Toronto Blue Jays with our mom while they enjoyed munchies that mom would make them. Anyone who knew Dad also knew that he loved to shop and loved Las Vegas and was hoping to make a trip back there again one day.
