say.*

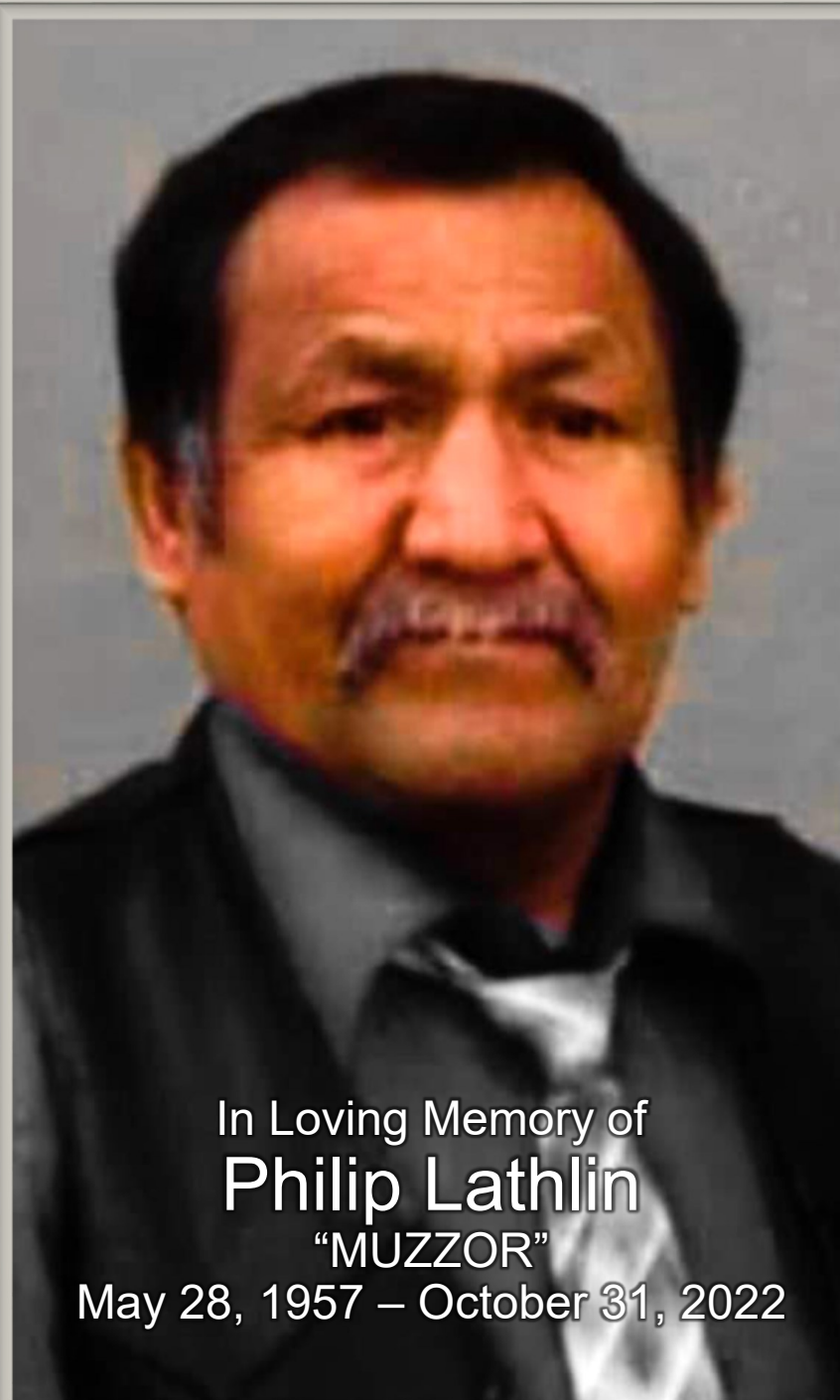
