

Jeff was a friendly, outgoing person. Whenever he met someone, he always gave a fake name like Raoul, because he didn't like the name the Government gave him. He did however like his spirit name, Thunderbird Child. Jeff was a very good story teller. He would often tell stories of his life and use those stories to try and help young people. He

was asked on several occasions to share his stories to help youth at risk.

Even through his hardships, Jeff always had a positive outlook on life and always tried to improve his lifestyle. He loved to attend sweats and was walking on the red road. He was a good helper and never complained. Whenever someone asked him to do something he would always jump up and do it. He was very respectful in nature, a prime example of his respectfulness is whenever Grandpa Isaac needed something done around the house, he would jump to it and say there you go Sir.

One of Jeff's Favorite pastimes was watching sports, such as hockey and football. His favorite teams were the Toronto Maple Leafs and the Saskatchewan Rough Riders. He often made friendly sports wagers with friends. He also liked to buy sports select and watch UFC.
