all the days of my life:



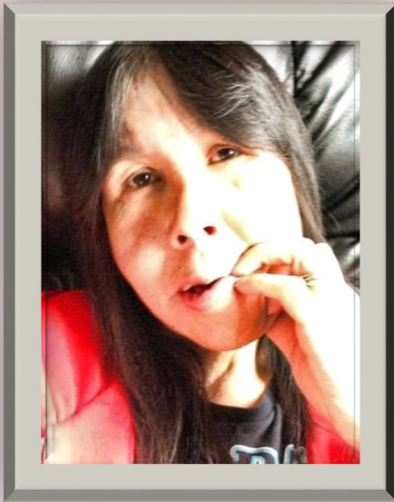

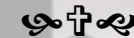
