

When dad fished and trapped, he would take kids out with him because they loved working with him. He was once the Mayor of Cormorant and a councillor. He was a Wildlife Management member. Ken also had his own ricing business and worked with heavy equipment and made a lot of the roads in Cormorant. He was also involved in making the community gardens. Ken was really a Jack-of-all-trades.

Grandpa Ken was a kind, loving father. When we brought our friends home, he treated them the same way as us. He was always there for his family. He loved and enjoyed his grandchildren. He was always there when you needed help. He was really funny and loved to laugh. He would voluntarily take the baseball players to play baseball in different communities. He paid for their baseball uniforms and he bought a bus to transport the players to their games. He was a really hard worker and would always take the kids to the fairs, the circus, every family movie at the Lido, the trips to The Pas just to go to the Dutch or Dairy Queen. We remember it all and love you for it.

Ken passed away with family by his side at 11:00 am, Monday, May 31, 2021 at his home in Cormorant, Manitoba, at the age of 86 years.
