

Heaven's Little Angel

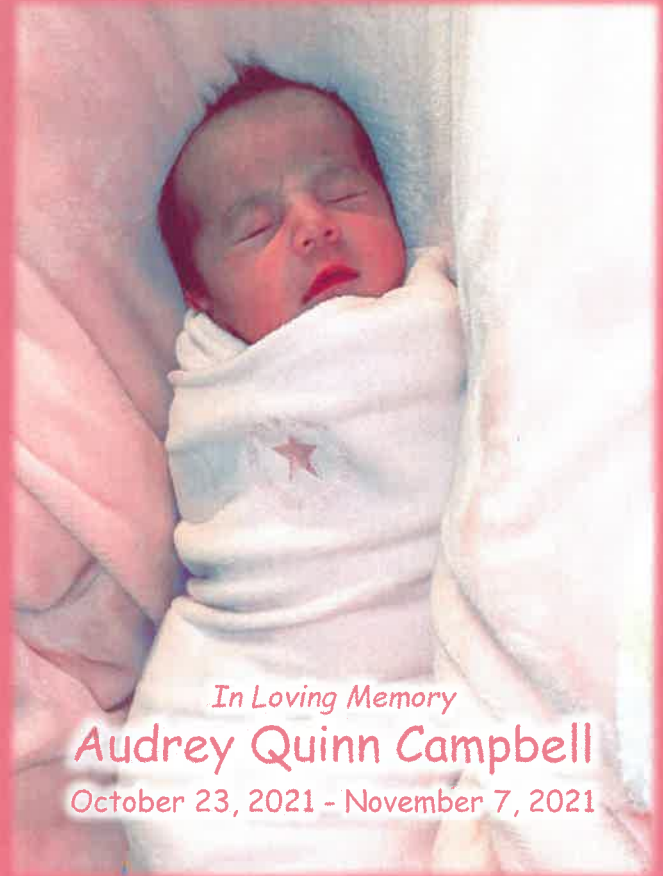
You're one of Heaven's angels now
