

Curriculum Overview

Museum: Our Sacred Story children will be hearing - "Parable of the Sower" and "Parable of the Mustard Seed".

Game: Children will gain more understanding of the Parable of the Sower by going through an obstacle course based on what type of "ground" they are representing.

Science: Children will do experiments that will help them understand how God's Kingdom can grow. What should we be doing in the world that would help bring God's Kingdom into people's lives.

Café: Children will explain how the parable of a mustard seed applies to them with friends, siblings, others. They will make snack bags for Franktown as a way to plant seeds of God's Word with other children.

Puppet/ Theater:

K-4th: Children will hear the story of the ungrateful servant. They will then act out the story themselves as they discuss ways to be merciful to others.

Art: Children will discuss what it means to let their light shine before others. They will learn what a Herodian lamp looked like and make a clay version in class.
