Community Liaison Committee - Member Application Form

The Nation Rise Wind Farm Limited Partnership (the "Proponent") is now inviting members of the public to join the Community Liaison Committee (CLC), including landowners and residents within 1 km of the Nation Rise Wind Farm (the "Project"), Indigenous communities, local municipality and conservation authority, local social and environmental organizations, agricultural and business communities, and representatives from local agencies.

The Project will be forming a CLC in accordance with the Project's Renewable Energy Approval (REA) [0871-AV3TFM] in order to exchange ideas, share interests, express concerns and provide updates about the Project with members of the public, Indigenous communities and other stakeholders during the construction and operation phases. Various aspects including, construction, installation, use, operation, maintenance and retirement of the Project will be discussed. A Terms of Reference will be created and agreed upon by the CLC members to structure the CLC meetings.

The CLC will consist of up to 12 participants selected to provide a broad and balanced perspective. CLC members will be encouraged to share any information from the CLC discussions with other interested community members. Each CLC members will be responsible for attending a minimum of four (4) meetings over a two-year period. Meetings will take place on a weekday evening in the Township of North Stormont, for approximately two hours each. The first CLC meeting is expected to take place in January - March 2019.

Selection for the CLC membership will consider:

- Experience with service in committees;
- Ability to work in team environments;
- Knowledge of the local community;
- Leadership within the community; and
- Interest in working productively to enable two-way communication between the Project and the community.

Membership of the CLC does not constitute support, endorsement, or opposition of the Project and potential members will not be selected with bias on this basis. CLC membership is a voluntary activity and its members will serve without remuneration.
