Tampa Sailing Squadron (TSS) is the organizing authority (OA).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Amendments, if any, to this Notice of Race will be posted on the official bulletin board at TSS.
Amended time of skippers meeting
- 1.3 Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official bulletin board at TSS and available the morning of the regatta.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the Daysailer Class and the Mutineer 15 class.

3. ENTRY/REGISTRATION

- 3.1 Before Nov. 10, 2021, enter by notifying Darin O'Neal at darin.oneal@stantec.com or cell 813-928-4112 to and provide shirt sizes
- 3.2 Late registration on-site the day of the event is allowed, but shirts cannot be guaranteed. A limited number of shirts and /or sizes may still be available for late registration.
- 3.3 The entry/registration deadline is 9 a.m. on Dec. 4, 2021.

4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is **\$35**. The entry fee includes 2 regatta shirts, burgers and beer after the racing. A \$5.00 discount is available to current US Sailing Members who provide a copy of their card or their Member Number at registration.
- 4.2 A limited number of extra dinner tickets may be available for the dinners on-site.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, Dec. 4, 2021

- 8 a.m. – 9 a.m - On-site check-in, late registration.
- 9:30** a.m. – Skippers meeting.
- 11 a.m. – Warning signal for first race. Additional races follow. No race will start after 3 p.m.
- 4:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. – beer, burgers, awards

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available on-site the day of the regatta.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 A minimum of three completed races are required to complete the regatta.

7.2 If five or more races are sailed, a boat's worst score shall be discarded.

8. AWARDS

8.1 Awards will be given to skipper and crew for places 1 - 3.

9. MISCELLANEOUS

9.1 This regatta is a "Clean Regatta." Racers are encouraged to use non-single use water bottles and recycle all appropriate items. Racers shall not intentionally put trash in the water.

10. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Racers in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other official or agent) will not be responsible or liable for any damage to any boat or other property or any personal injury or death of any participant, in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Each competitor agrees to participate entirely at his/her own risk and, to the fullest extent permitted by law, waives any rights to sue the race organizers and releases the race organizers from any and all liability, in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
