The Société de Chimie Industrielle will award the 2019 biennial International Palladium Medal to FMC Corporation Chairman and Chief Executive Officer Pierre Brondeau for his contributions to the chemical industry and his leadership in enhancing the international aims and objectives of the Société de Chimie Industrielle. He will receive the award at a dinner in his honor on May 22, 2019, in New York City. We are pleased that Raj L.Gupta will be introducing the awardee at the gala

I, as Chairman of the Palladium Medal Committee, and Raj Gupta, as Pierre's introducer at the dinner, are seeking the support of corporate colleagues, friends of Pierre Brondeau and friends of the Société de Chimie Industrielle. You can show that support by taking a Donor Table at this event.

All of the net proceeds from the purchases of Donor Tables fund the non-profit activities of the Société, including scholarships for students studying chemical engineering and chemistry, a very successful mentoring program, and educational lectures/luncheons and webinars for industry executives, students and others. All of these activities further the Societe's primary mission of promoting global understanding of the chemical and allied industries.

The International Palladium Medal is typically awarded every two years to a leading executive who has won the respect and admiration of the international business community and whose contribution to the industry is "of such character and scope as to enhance the international aims and objectives of the Société de Chimie Industrielle."

The Palladium award was established in 1958 and the first medal was presented to Ernest-John Solvay of Belgium. Twenty-seven subsequent awards have been made to American, French, British, and German recipients. Recent recipients include: Seifi Ghasemi (Air Products), Ellen Kullman, (DuPont), Andrew N. Liveris (Dow Chemical), Vincent A. Calarco (Chemtura), Charles O. Holliday, Jr. (DuPont), Jeffery M. Lipton (Nova Chemicals), William S. Stavropolous (Dow), and Jürgen F. Strube (BASF).

I am sure you will agree that this award is especially fitting for Pierre because of his lifelong contributions to the chemical industry that exemplify the reasons why the International Palladium Medal Award was established 60 years ago.

Brondeau joined FMC in 2010 as president and chief executive officer and was named chairman of the board later that year. He previously served as president and chief executive officer of Dow Advanced Materials, a division of The Dow Chemical Company. Prior to Dow, Brondeau was president and chief operating officer of Rohm and Haas Company, which was acquired by Dow Chemical in 2009.

During his 20-year career at Rohm and Haas, Brondeau held numerous executive and commercial positions in Europe and the United States with regional and global responsibilities for marketing, sales, research and development, engineering, technology and operations. Prior to joining Rohm and Haas, he spent six years at Air Liquide in Paris and Chicago in engineering, research and development, and marketing.

We offer donor tables that are in the front of the ballroom close to the dais at **\$12,500** (Premium Palladium level) and at **\$10,000** (Palladium level). Each table seats 10 people. We will acknowledge purchasers of donor tables at the dinner and in the printed program. In addition, 10 one year memberships to the Société de Chimie Industrielle are included.
