Notice of Race

Kitsilano Yacht Club invites you to compete in the 2018 Passage Island Race.

Rules and Regulations

This race will be governed by: The current ISF Racing Rules of Sailing; the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association; the rules of the eligible classes; this Notice of Race; the REGULATIONS FOR THE PREVENTION OF COLLISIONS; and the requirements of the Vancouver Port Authority.

Remember, you will be sailing in a shipping channel and you will likely encounter commercial vessels restricted in their ability to maneuver.

As this is a distance race; for safety **only** please carry a cell phone or VHF radio on board, for assistance, raise the KYC safety boat on channel 68 or call the KYC office. In an emergency, contact the Canadian Coast Guard.

Eligibility

This is an open race for boats with current Portsmouth Ratings. Ratings will be applied based on average reported wind conditions at Point Atkinson from 1200 to the time of the first boat finishing. Please have your Portsmouth Rating when you register.

Registration

Registration will take place at the Kitsilano Yacht Club office between 1000 and 1100 on Sunday, September 2nd, or by filling out printing and filling this form by return and acknowledgement.

Fees for Registration: Free for all competitors both KYC members and non-KYC members

Race Information

The first signal for the start of this race will be made 1200 Sunday, September 2nd, There will be only one start for all boats.

Signals will be made from the Floating Dock. Race shall be started as follows:

-5 minutes Raise X Class Flag (plus one sound signal)

-4 minutes Raise "P" Flag (plus one sound signal)

-1 minute Lower "P" Flag (plus one sound signal)
Start = Lower X Class Flag (plus one sound signal)

Course

The Start/Finish line is between two orange tetrahedron marks North of the KYC floating dock. (The orange buoys marking underwater hazards to the north west of the float and swimming zones in Kits beach are not marks of the course – please use caution around them). The only other mark of the course is Passage Island which may be left to either Port or Starboard. Round Passage Island in the direction of your choice. The final leg of the course is directly to the start/finish line at KYC.

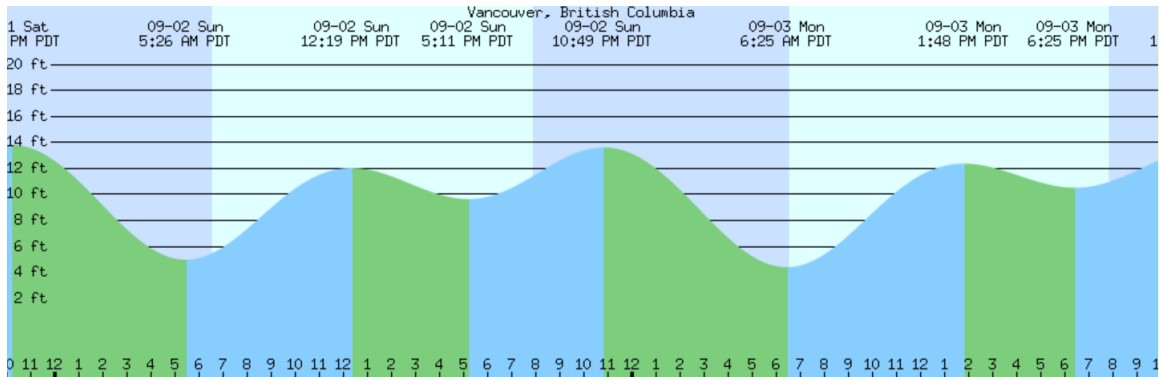
In the absence of the finish tetrahedron marks, the finish line is within 20 meters due North of the NE corner of KYC floating dock.

No boats will be recorded as having finished after 19:53 (sunset).

In order to be scored for this event, finishers must submit their elapsed time between start and finish (HH:MM:SS) to the KYC Office before 2030 on Sunday September 2nd. The elapsed time must be notified to the KYC office by text message or email from the boats skipper, along with boat name boat class and skippers name.
