Lander County is located in north central Nevada, 4,513 feet above sea level at 40:38:32N - Longitude: by 116:56:00W - Latitude. The average annual precipitation is 7.49 inches, while the average annual snow fall is over double that amount with 17.1 inches. The average annual temperature is 65.6 degrees. The July average high is 93 degrees with the January average low 26.5 degrees. We get an amazing amount of sunshine with 267 days and a growing season of 106 days.

Battle Mountain offers many recreation facilities; Basketball courts, Baseball fields, Copper Basin Bike Trail, Football fields, 9 Hole Golf Course, Playgrounds/ Parks, Skate Park, Race Track, Rodeo Grounds, Soccer Fields, Tennis Courts, and a Swimming Pool.
