Village Without Walls at Celebrate Hillsboro

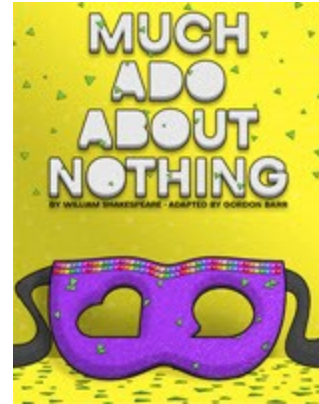

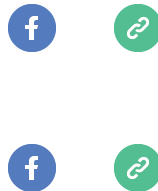
Villagers are going to the Ballpark!
