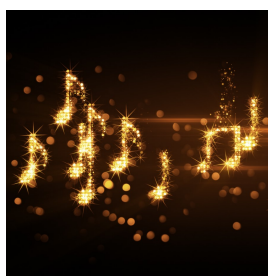


Village Without Walls
