

English Paper Piecing Class Supply List

- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Cutting mat at least 12" x 18"
- Fabric scissors full size
- Fabric scissors smaller for detail work
- Pins and pin cushion
- Fine thread for hand sewing in various neutral colors or to match fabrics
- Glue pen and refills (optional but preferred)
- Cover clips
- Fabrics
- Hand sewing needles (I like #11 Milliner)
- optional-needle threader
- optional-thimble

* I will have some supplies for purchase available during class

The size of the finished project is approx. 21" x 21"

Note about fabrics:

You will be working on a pillow size project unless you are bringing your own project to work on. Fabrics that have smaller repeats are best for fussy cutting. Make sure you bring enough fabric to fussy cut an image and that it is repeated 5 times. I suggest 1/2 yard cuts of 3 prints for fussy cutting and 12 fat quarters of coordinating prints, as the minimum.

You can also bring a background fabric 28" x 28" for the pillow that we can audition for color.

I would also suggest bringing some fabrics that contrast those fussy cutting prints. Solids work well or tiny small scale prints.

I will be providing the papers and printed pattern for the Pollinate Pillow. This rosette can also be incorporated into the larger mother pattern of the Pollinate Quilt if you wish to take it further than the pillow. Most students will not be able to finish the pillow in the class time allowed. Our goal will be to learn the skills for english paper piecing.
