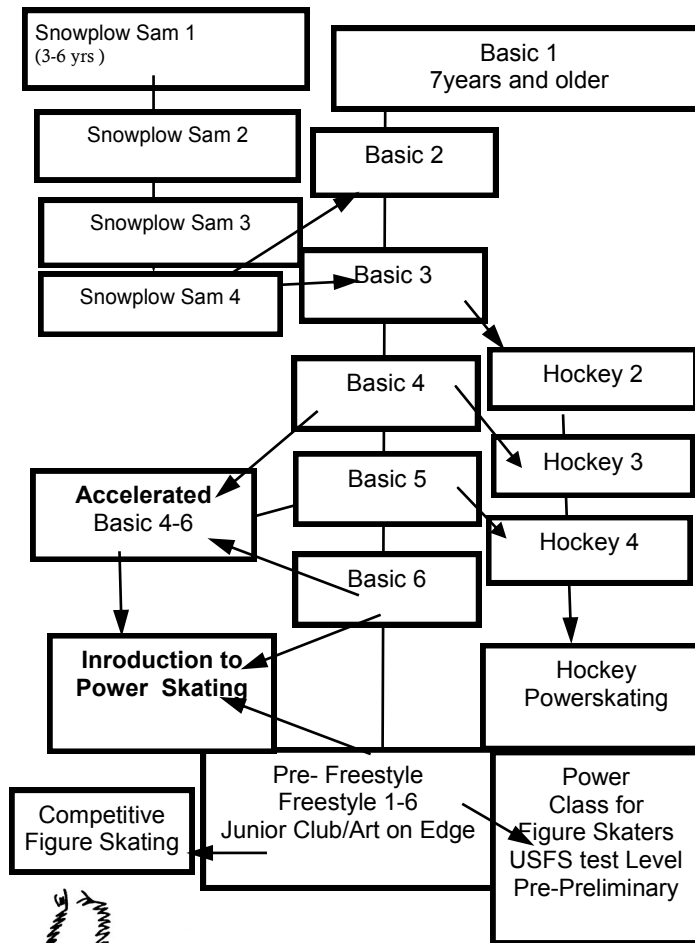
To avoid a Late Fee, on line registration must be completed two days prior to the start of each session. You may pay on line or by check the first day of class.

Class Procedure—Equipment

- Helmets are recommended—beginners and tots
- Loose fitting warm clothing—mittens
- Arrive 15 minutes before class -
- Check in at the registration desk
- Use the assigned locker rooms - usually #1
- The first day we meet in the lobby.
- Good “rink” skates are available free for use during your class
