About the Chapter: The Dublin South Central Area Chapter supports the south-central area of Georgia. The chapter currently has 16 active members. Chapter meetings are held at 5:30 p.m. on the 1st Monday of each month at the Oconee Regional Library in Dublin. The chapter is constantly recruiting new alumni members. Chapter Awards/Recognitions: The Dublin South Central Area Chapter is recognized as a member of ASU Dream Team by the purchase of a Band Uniform. Also, the chapter received an award for participating in the Martin Luther King Jr. Parade. The chapter was awarded \$9,000 from a local 501(c)3 non-profit organization to establish a Katherine Gray/ Emory Thomas scholarship to be awarded (\$500) to a student attending Albany State University.

Scholarship Awards: The chapter awards the following two annual scholarships: the Katherine Gray/Emory Thomas Scholarship (\$500) and the Dublin South Central Area Chapter Scholarship (\$1000).

Student Recruitment: Members of the chapter supported recruitment of ASU students by participating in annual campus visitation (Open House) for juniors and seniors at area high schools. Additionally, the chapter secured information from ASU Office of Recruitment and distributed it at the Martin Luther King Annual Parade

Community Service Projects: Dublin Alumni Chapter assisted the community as volunteers at the Dublin Middle School with "A Neck Tie Project" and participated in the Salvation Army "Can Good Drive". Chapter members volunteer as readers at a Primary School and participated in the Annual Career Day at a local high school.

Fundraising Activities: During the Fall, the chapter sponsors a trip to the Fountain City Classic---Chapter develops a package deal that is sold for a small profit to the chapter The Spring Fundraising is a Scholarship Donation Event --Donations are accepted and a financial give-a-way takes place to the winners. All proceeds go to the Scholarship Fund. In previous years, the "Christmas Tour of Homes" has been used as a chapter fundraiser.
