



INSURANCE COLLECTION EXECUTIVES PRIVACY POLICY

In the course of our professional relationship, Insurance Collection Executives (“ICE”) will obtain information from its members so that ICE can better serve the needs of its members. ICE places a high priority on protecting your privacy and safeguarding the information provided to ICE. This Privacy Policy explains the types of information collected, how it is used by ICE and the steps taken by ICE to preserve your privacy..

ICE collects certain information from our members, vendors and exhibitors. This information includes e-mail addresses, names, titles, employers and other contact or profile information. ICE members are requested but not required to voluntarily provide additional information on the Member Profile page on the ICE website. Information provided by ICE members on the Profile page is only available to ICE members and its staff.

Before and at the annual ICE Conference, the names of conference attendees are posted on the ICE Conference app. Conference attendees can share contact information with other conference attendees, sponsors or exhibitors. ICE has no control over and assumes no liability for the dissemination of information by Conference attendees.

Conference attendee contact information is shared with ICE Conference sponsors, exhibitors and sometimes Conference speakers. ICE informs recipients that this information cannot be sold to any third parties or used for any commercial purpose.

From time to time ICE members may share their access to the ICE Members website page with other employees within their company. By sharing access with other employees you agree that all employees granted such access will comply with and be bound by this Privacy Policy

ICE uses this information for specific, limited purposes such as communications with its members. The information is also used for tracking metrics such as website visitor traffic. The information collected allows ICE to send e-mail alerts and notifications to you, to answer your requests and to process applications and registrations that may be submitted. Information sent or received on the ICE website is transmitted via a secured server using encryption technology.

Upon your written request, ICE will not provide your information to anyone and ICE will not communicate with you via e-mail.

ICE does not provide, rent, sell or disclose e-mail addresses or other collected information to anyone outside of ICE.

There are certain links on the ICE website that are not under the control or within the domain of ICE. ICE is not responsible for the privacy practices or content of these external websites.

In addition, certain presenters of online webinars may collect information from ICE members. ICE is not responsible for the privacy practices of these presenters. The disclosure of information to webinar presenters or website links is at your own risk.

ICE may amend this Privacy Policy from time to time; please review it periodically. We reserve the right to modify this Privacy Policy at any time by electronic notice posted on our website. Your continued use of our website after the date that such notices are posted will be deemed your acceptance of any such changes.
