Eligibility and Rules: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2013-2016), Scantlings of the NCESA, and the Sailing Instructions. Yachts must display the Active Owner NCESA Membership sticker as described in the Scantlings. Eligible yachts must enter by completing the Entry Form, which will be available at registration.

Racing and Courses: There will be two fleets, Gold and Silver, entry in either by competitor's choice. Both fleets will sail together. Windward-leeward courses will be sailed with the option of a downwind finish. There will be a maximum of 5 races sailed.

Scoring: The low point system, Appendix A2 of The Racing Rules of Sailing, will be used. No throw outs will be allowed.
