DBC Learn to Sail Program

KEY Benefits of the DBC program are:

- The longest running summer class session (April 4 - September 26) of 25 weeks allows for the ability to miss some classes, then catch up.

Class Description

Novice Sailing Program

DBC is proud to offer this entry-level class for students who have little or no sailing experience. It is held jointly with the Edison Boat Club, at their clubhouse on the Detroit River at 100 Lycaste, Detroit. The course is designed to be a simple and entertaining introduction to sailing and water safety. Each sailor will learn the basics of sailing: parts of the boat, rigging (set up) sails, steering the boat, leaving & returning to the dock under sail, and water safety. Students are also introduced to basics of racing with their fellow students and will have opportunities to race against other clubs as the class progresses.

This is a hands-on, get-wet (from bow spray, not capsizes) and have-a-lot of fun type of class. This course is designed to build skills and confidence through time on the water, chats on shore, and focus on fundamentals of sailing, safety and boat handling. Full Tuition for the Beginner Class is \$355 (\$205 if you are already a DBC member). The fee is \$205 for additional family members.

Course is based on US Sailing material and hands on sailing. No previous boating experience is required.

Requirements

Sailors should be at least 14 years old (those who have not yet entered into high school must have a parent who is also taking the class). Sailors must weigh at least 80 lbs and feel comfortable around the water. Sailors need to be on time. All participants must wear a proper fitting life jacket at all times on the docks and boats! If you do not own a life jacket, one can be provided for you! Shoes are required to be worn at all times on the docks! A spare set of clothes is recommended. *As guests of EBC All participants must act in a respectful manner on the grounds and in the water. This is an instructional program to teach the fundamentals of sailing. We may dismiss any student if they do not respect the basic rules of the club and/or the program. Please note: There is a 10 mph speed limit on the property that must be obeyed.*

Recommended:

Bring and wear sun block, sunglasses & hat with retaining straps and towel.
