Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Nagawicka Lake, located in Delafield, WI.

SCHEDULE

Check-In, Registration & Measurement: Thursday, July 12 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and from 8:00 AM until 9:00 AM on Friday July 13, at NLYC.

Registration is not completed until measurement and weight requirements have been checked and Sailing Instructions and Waiver of Liability have been acknowledged.

Launching: Once registration is complete, launching will occur at Headquarters. Trailer parking will be available off-site.

Competitors Briefings: The competitors' briefing will occur at 9:00 a.m. Friday July 13th.

Race Schedule: The schedule of events is as follows:

Friday July 13, 10:00 1st Warning Signal

The time of the warning signal for subsequent races will be posted except when races are sailed back-to-back. On the last day of the regatta, no warning signal will be made after 1200 hours if three races have been completed. If fewer than three races have been completed, no warning signal will be made after 1500 hours.

Saturday and Sunday, July 14 & 15, 2018 Warning Signal TBA

Sunday, July 16, 2018

Awards ceremony after racing at regatta headquarters.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Regatta is open to skippers who comply with the requirements prescribed by the ILYA bylaws and are Family, Regular, Youth, or Life members of the ILYA.

Crew become members of the Association by virtue of their yacht's completed registration.

Eligible boats may enter by completing an official entry form available at [Regatta Toolbox](#), on-site at Headquarters or downloading an official entry form and mailing it with the required fee to the ILYA at P.O. Box 662, East Troy, WI 53120. The entry form is considered part of the NOR even though it is a separate form.

All entries must be received or postmarked by June 30, 2018 to avoid late penalties. Internet registrations require payment via Visa/MC/Amex/Discover cards.

Entry is not complete until entrants have signed the entry form and warranted that no changes to the yacht or its equipment have been made since it was last weighed and certified. Entrants who answer in the negative will need to meet with the Technical Committee on-site to gain compliance.

FEES

The entry fee is \$90.00, youth fee is \$45.00.

Entries received after June 30, 2018 will be subject to an additional fee of \$20.00 if membership is made online. On-site registration day total fee is \$120.00.

The cost for meals and other activities are described in supplemental information available at the [Regatta Toolbox Event Website](#), NLYC website or via printed materials available during Check-In at Headquarters.

COURSES

The racing area will be on the navigable waters of Nagawicka Lake in Waukesha County, WI. The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions, available at Check-In.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor, or in the case of minors, each competitor's parent or guardian agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

RULES

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The organizing authority (OA) for this regatta is the Inland Lakes Yachting Association (ILYA).

2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2.2 RRS 33.(c) is changed as follows: After the start, minor adjustments in a mark's location can be made and will not be signaled.

2.3 RRS 35, A4.2, and A11 are changed as follows: Boats still racing 25 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored TLE (Time Limit Expired), the position of the last boat that complies with RRS 28 to finish plus 2. This changes RRS 35, A4.2, and A11.

2.4 RRS 30.1 is changed as follows: If a mid-line boat is in place in accordance with SI 5.3, a boat may return to the pre-start side of the starting line around the mid-line boat, leaving it to port, before starting.

2.5 RRS 62.1(a) is modified as follows: Following the display of Code Flag "X", every effort will be made to hail a complete list of boats identified on the course side at the start or needing to comply with RRS 30.1 as quickly and clearly as possible by VHF radio. Please note that due to this hail being a courtesy, it is extremely unlikely that redress will be granted because of the order of numbers called, failure to hear a hail, or failure to understand a hail. This changes RRS 41

2.6 RRS 41 is changed as follows: A capsized boat that is righted by outside help shall NOT be required to retire.

2.7 RRS A2.1 is changed as follows: Each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. If six or more races have been completed, each boat shall discard her worst score, except where prohibited under RRS 90.3(b).

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all MC Class boats whose skipper is a family, regular, youth or life member of the ILYA.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an official entry form available at the [Regatta Toolbox website](#) online, at regatta headquarters or downloading an official entry form at www.ILYA.org and mailing it with the required fee to the ILYA at P.O. Box 662, East Troy, WI 53120. The entry form is considered part of the NoR even though it is a separate form.

3.3 All entries must be received or postmarked by June 30, 2018 to avoid late penalties. Internet registrations require payment via Visa/MC/Amex/Discover cards.

3.4 Entry is not complete until entrants have signed the entry form and warranted that no changes to the yacht or its equipment have been made since it was last weighed and certified. Entrants who answer in the negative will need to meet with the Technical Committee on-site to gain compliance.

4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee is \$90.00, \$45.00 youth.

4.2 Entries received after June 30, 2018 will be subject to an additional fee of \$20.00

4.3 The cost for meals and other activities are described in supplemental information available at www.ilya.com or via printed materials available during check-in at the regatta headquarters.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 A maximum of seven races may be sailed with no more than three races sailed in one day.

SOCIAL

All organized activities will be at Headquarters:

Food: Lunches and lunch packages will be available for all meals as well as Saturday night dinner.

Entertainment: A Saturday night dinner party will be provided for and additional fee. As always the N.L.Y.C. bar will be open and a ready all days!

TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded as follows: Keeper trophies will be awarded to the top five skippers, top five crew, top youth, top female, top master, and top grand master. Any ILYA perpetual trophies will be awarded per the relevant deed of gift.

MEDIA RIGHTS

Competitors give absolute right and permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat generated during an ILYA event to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

MISCELLANEOUS

Mooring and Taxi: The MC's will be moored across from NLYC on the southwest shore of the lake. **Bring** your own anchor, buoy, and line (12-15 feet). Water in the mooring area is between 6-10 feet deep. The bottom is a mixture of sand, stones and mud with some weeds. Shuttle boats will be available for taxi service. The shuttle boats will also be available to tow MC boats to the mooring area after launching. There will be **NO** dry sailing allowed on the N.L.Y.C. facilities. No exceptions.

Launching: Help prevent the spread of Eurasian milfoil and other exotic plants. Please be sure your trailer is free of all weeds before you launch. There are no boat or trailer washing facilities on the NLYC grounds, so please wash your boat and trailer before you arrive. Due to space, once your boat is set-up it, it will be expected to be launched and taken to the mooring field.

Spectator Boats: Spectator Boats will be provided for all races. If you plan on bringing your own boat to spectate the boat cannot be launched at the N.L.Y.C. during the regatta. Alternative launch facilities are located at Naga-Waukeee Park next to the N.L.Y.C., however a launch fee(s) will apply.
