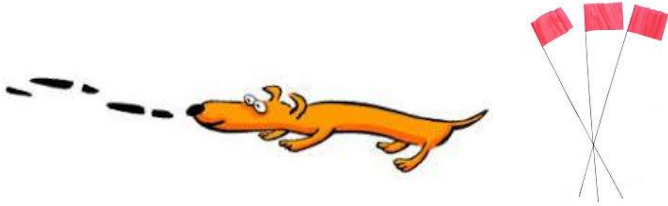


FIELD & URBAN TRACKING SEMINAR

Participants are encouraged to attend all 3 days of the seminar as approximately 50% of the seminar is classroom instruction detailing theory and application.

Seminar Locations and Logistics

Home base for the Seminar will be at the Wesen Organic Dairy Farms, located in Bow, WA. The training facility on site will be used for classroom training, and the fields in and around Wesen Farms will be used for the field tracking portion of the seminar. The urban tracking portion of the Seminar will take place at various sites located in the nearby vicinity, e.g. parks, schools. The training facility will be home base each morning as well as for wrap-up discussions. Start and finish times will be announced after registration.

Hospitality will be offered for both breakfast and lunch, along with refreshments. Please let us know if you have any dietary restrictions.

Working Dogs

A questionnaire will be emailed to all working teams which is to be completed and returned two weeks prior to the seminar to establish a participant baseline. The seminar is divided almost equally between classroom presentation and field work. An emphasis is placed on teaching the canine the required skill sets necessary to title while building the canine's confidence and motivation.

If a working team has no previous experience, then the team will be assigned an experienced dog trainer to help and assist them. This assistance is only necessary just prior to when the novice team tracks.

Auditors

Auditors are permitted and are expected to participate in classroom discussion and field observation. There is great value in auditing, as the seminar is 50% classroom instruction detailing theory and application.

General- What to Bring

All working spot attendees are requested to bring a notebook, pen/pencil, a chair, crate, tracking harness, tracking line, tracking articles, training treats if applicable, tracking flags. Prepare for weather. There is little shade at both home base and urban tracking sites. Please bring appropriate sun-shading for your vehicle for safety purposes.
