TRAVEL RELEASE AND WAIVER

In CONSIDERATION of (student name(s) *Please Print*)

(the “Participant(s)”) being allowed to travel to and from Albany, Georgia by bus transportation provided through a professional bus service arranged by the ASUNAA DeKalb County Area Alumni Chapter to participate in the Albany State University’s Open House to take place on Saturday, March 28, 2020 (the “Event”).

Understanding and acknowledging that the ASUNAA DeKalb County Area Alumni Chapter (“ASUNAA DCAAC”) is a non-profit organization that supports Albany State University, we, the Participant(s) and the parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s) of the Participant(s), jointly and severally, and intending to legally bind ourselves and our child(ren) (collectively the “Releasers”) acknowledge and agree that the ASUNAA DCAAC is not an agent of the professional bus service providing the transportation to and from the Event and the ASUNAA DCAAC has no responsibility for the professional bus service or any third party, including without limitation any services, equipment, employees or agents provided by any third parties or activities associated with travel to and from the Event. The Releasers do hereby waive, release and discharge, and covenant not to sue, the ASUNAA DCAAC, and its officers, directors, trustees, employees, staff, volunteers, and supervisors and their successors and assigns (collectively the “Releasees”) from any and all liability and/or claims, suits, damages, injury, disability, death, costs and expenses, whether arising during travel to or from the Event, whether arising before, during or after the Event and whether caused by the sole or joint negligence, gross negligence, or tortious act or omission of the Releasees or any third party (collectively the “Claims”). The Releasers hereby knowingly and voluntarily waive, to the fullest extent permitted by law, the benefits of any statute, law, rule, or common law which may limit the scope of this Release and Waiver.

Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, this Release and Waiver does not release and is not intended to release any claims Releasers may have against any person and/or party other than the Releasees. Moreover, notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the willful misconduct of the Releasees is expressly excluded from the scope and application of this Release and Waiver.

The Releasers are aware of, and understand fully, the potential risks involved in connection with travel to and from the Event and that serious injury and death may occur, and each of them assume full, sole, and complete responsibility for, and risks of, death, personal or bodily injury, disability and/or property damage resulting from, in connection with, or in any way related to, Participant’s participation in travel to and from the Event and the Event itself. The Releasers understand that the ASUNAA DCAAC has not certified or investigated the professional bus service providing the transportation to and from the Event and makes no statement or warrant as to the safety of said transportation.

The Releasers represent and warrant to the Releasees, that Participant(s) has no medical condition (physical or mental) which would or could impact on the Releasees allowing Participant to travel to and from the Event and that the Participant(s) is/are physically able to travel to and from the Event.

Releaser also acknowledges that the Participant(s) agrees to follow the instructions of all chaperones, employees, agents and representatives of the ASUNAA DCAAC.

Furthermore, the Releasers acknowledge that the Releasers have received the opportunity (and been strongly encouraged) to review this Release and Waiver with an attorney, that the Releasers have carefully read and fully understand the contents of this Release and Waiver and that the Releasers have duly executed this Release and Waiver freely and voluntarily, intending and agreeing to be fully bound by the terms hereof.
