Greetings My Brothers,

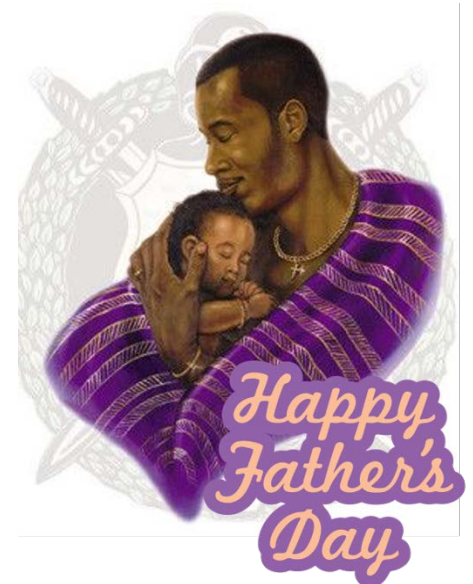

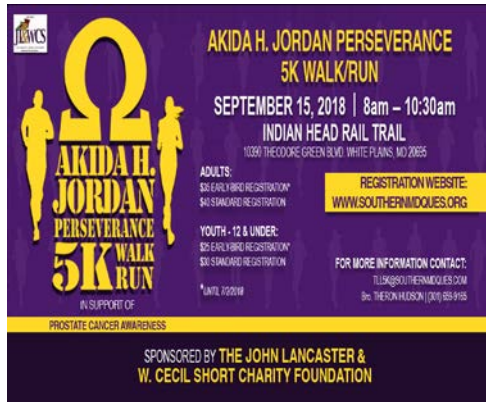
