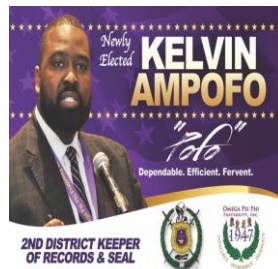
BASILEUS CORNER

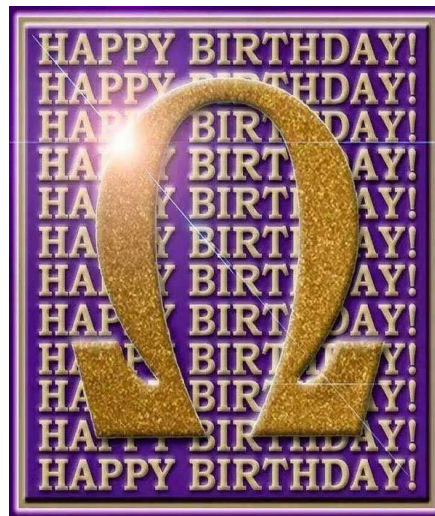

The AKRS and I are still working to update our chapter records. If your information has changed please fill out a note card or send an email to KRS@munuques.org with your updated information.

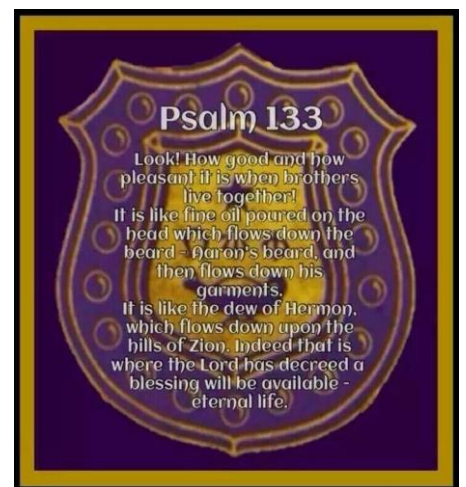
Dues:
