To Get Started

Follow the list of steps below to start your free membership.

- From the web type in: <http://www.electricauto.org>
- From the top menu tabs select “EAA Chapters”.
- Select a state and search which chapter is closest to you.
- Once you find a state, select from the left hand column “Join the EAA” (*If a chapter is not nearby select the closest one. The chapter can be changed at any time or one can be added.*)
- The “Join the EAA” page will bring you to the “Select Your Member Type”. Select “Member” then “continue”.
- On the next page you will now select your “User Name” insert your name and from the scroll down menu select the chapter you found closest to you, then select “continue”.
- Now you will select the membership type.
- Scroll down and select the “3 Months Free Promo”
- If you have a plug in hybrid select the “PHEV” option.

Key Acronyms

BEVs (all-electric vehicles)

Are powered only by one or more electric motors. They receive electricity by plugging into the grid and store it in batteries. They consume no petroleum-based fuel and produce no tailpipe emissions while driving.

EVSE (electric vehicle supply equipment)

Delivers electrical energy from an electricity source to charge a PEV's batteries. It communicates with the PEV to ensure that an appropriate and safe flow of electricity is supplied.

HEVs (hybrid electric vehicles)

Combine an ICE or other propulsion source with batteries, regenerative braking, and an electric motor to provide high fuel economy. They rely on a petroleum-based or alternative fuel for power and are not plugged in to charge. HEV batteries are charged by the ICE as the primary motive propulsion source and during regenerative braking.

ICEs (internal combustion engines)

Generate mechanical power by burning a liquid fuel (such as gasoline, diesel, or a biofuel) or a gaseous fuel (such as compressed natural gas). They are the dominant power source for on-road vehicles today.

PEVs (plug-in electric vehicles)

Derive all or part of their power from inexpensive electricity supplied by our domestic sources on the electric grid. They include EVs and PHEVs.

PHEVs (plug-in hybrid electric vehicles)

Use batteries to power an electric motor, plug into the electric grid to charge, and use a petroleum based or alternative fuel to power an ICE or other propulsion source.
