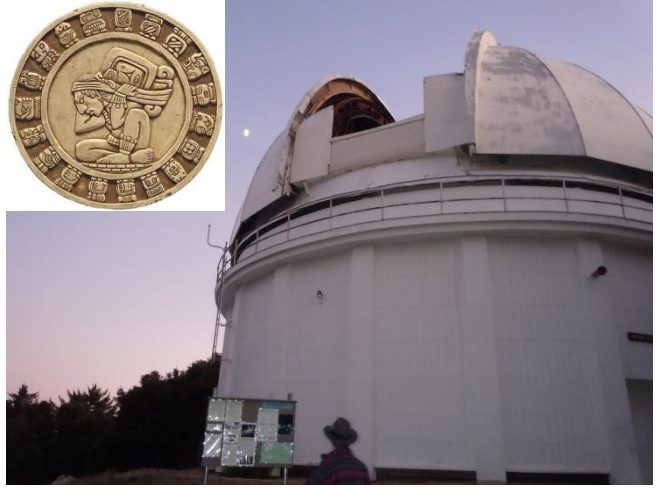
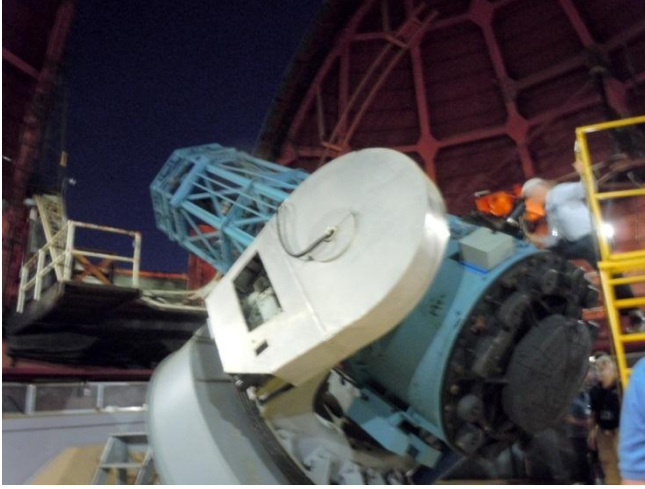

Wilson by **6:00 PM**, and viewing will conclude at 1 AM.
