

NMPA Mountain Flying Clinic Returns to Santa Fe

The acclaimed New Mexico Pilots Association Mountain Flying Clinic will be held again in Santa Fe, September 27 - 29, 2019. The Clinic, held at the Santa Fe Baptist Church, starts with an all day ground school on Friday covering the tools necessary to understand and plan for the unique and rewarding challenges of mountain flying. The 2019 curriculum includes mountain flight planning, aircraft performance, mountain weather, aeromedical factors, risk management & survival, mountain communications, and mountain flight maneuvers. Scheduled instructors include regionally and nationally recognized CFIs, including John Lorenz, John Kusianovich, J.D. Huss, and Cliff Chetwin.

Saturday and Sunday offer optional flight opportunities with a highly experienced mountain flying CFI over spectacular mountainous terrain, through mountain passes, and landings at several high-altitude airports. Successful completion of both the ground school and the optional flight will meet the flight review requirements of 14CFR61.56. Credits under the FAA WINGs Pilot Proficiency Program are available and some insurance companies will provide discounts for participating in this safety clinic.
