Runway 6/24 - Dirt in good condition

5100 feet long x 30 feet wide



There are power lines right on the threshold of runway 24, plus it slopes significantly downhill. If landing 24 make a right pattern.

If possible land runway 6 and only make a left pattern (there is terrain close to the south and west sides of the runway). By landing on Runway 6, grading is better from mid-field (from wider turnaround area), and you can roll out to the parking area. Taxi all the way to the end before turning toward parking to avoid ditches along the parking area.

PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF YOUR PROPWASH! It is very easy to kick up a dust storm and those camping will get a mouthful of your dust if you aren't careful.

Field is unlighted, plan to land well before dusk.

NOTE: No flour bombing contest this year.

Monitor and announce on 123.0 and be prepared for new information.
