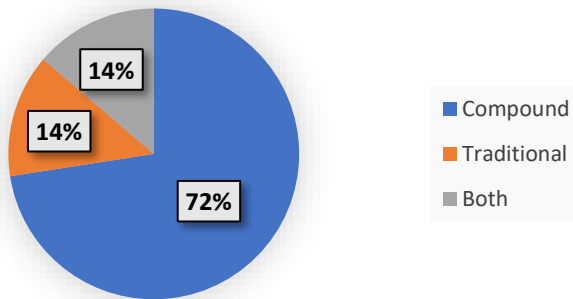

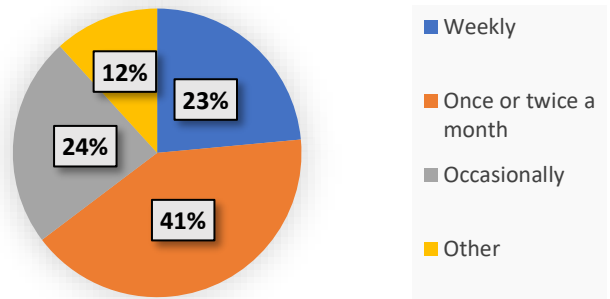
## Member Survey Results

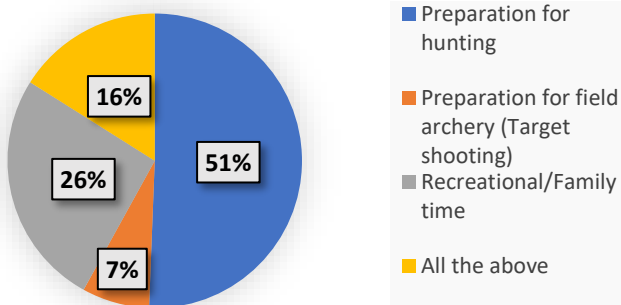
### Preferred Archery Style



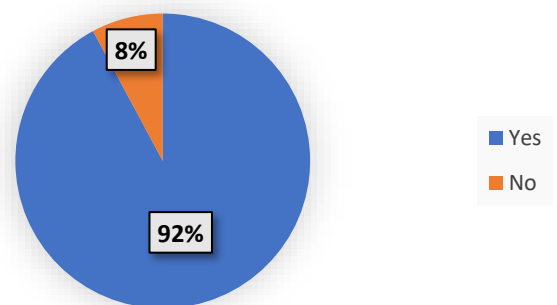
### Frequency of Range Use



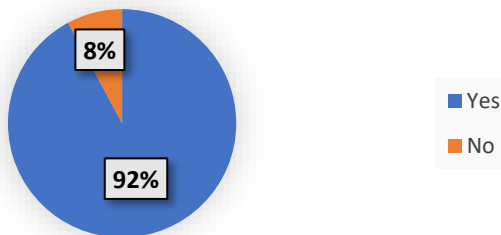
### Primary Reason for Joining

## Range Rebuild Plans (Dates TBD)

Based on member feedback at the Annual Meeting, we will add an elk and a deer to the broadhead range with plans to replace the vital area inserts frequently enough to avoid pass throughs. This will provide a more realistic target to practice with broadheads. We will also be adding more of the large block targets to the broadhead range since we learned last year that they hold up very well to broadheads. Please use the block targets for sighting in and general broadhead practice. This will minimize wear on the 3D targets and avoid issues with pass throughs on those targets.
