- **Program Overview**

- PA is now affiliated with the *Minnesota High School Equestrian Association (MHSEA)* to recognize the accomplishments of student riders in grades 8-12.
- Students must register with MHSEA April 1-May 13 to participate in the 2015-2016 program, and be in grades 8-11 at the time of registration. (The website lists the registration deadline as April 30, but PA has been given an introductory extension until May 13th.)
- Registration is completed online at <http://www.mhsea.org/> and costs \$75.00
- PA affiliated riders must be registered students at PA and maintain good institutional standing during the academic year. These riders will be awarded a certificate of participation from PA at the completion of each riding season. (November 1st, 2015-October 31st, 2016)
- Community service and MHSEA lettering points date back to November 1st of the registration year.

- **Lettering**

- Student riders who earn an MHSEA specified Varsity or JV letter will have an opportunity to display an MHSEA patch on a PA varsity letter jacket as an additional recognition *if* they have already earned a varsity letter in an official PA academic, athletic, or arts offering.
- PA does not officially issue a varsity letter for equestrian.
- All eligible riding events and community service hours are subject to the approval of MHSEA as outlined in the program handbook.
