2018 Year End Awards Program

Schooling Show Awards

Program Rules:

- Award year is December 1, 2017 to November 31, 2018
- Rider must be a GCC member in good standing on the date the score was awarded.
- Horse must be registered with ODS on the date the score was awarded.
- The horse and rider are considered a team for each level of competition.
- A horse/rider combination may not repeat as champion at the same level in succeeding years (second level or higher excluded).
- Rider must have volunteered a minimum of six (6) hours at a GCC function to be eligible for year-end awards. Rider must sign in on Volunteer Sheet at event and list on Awards Recording Form.
- Awards will be presented at the Annual General Meeting Awards Banquet.

Score Requirements:

- Minimum of five (5) scores.
- Minimum of three (3) different judges.
- At least one (1) score from the top test of the level (except in Intro Level where test B is required).
- All scores must be from GCC approved schooling shows.

Score submissions and Award Calculations:

- All eligible scores should be submitted along with a completed Year-End Awards Recording Form and copies of the front of each test.
- All eligible scores will be used to calculate the median.
- The median is the middle score when all scores are listed from highest to lowest.
- For an even number of scores, the two (2) middle scores are averaged to produce the median.

- Rider must be a GCC member in good standing on the date the score was awarded.
- Horse must be registered with ODS on the date the score was awarded.
- The horse and rider are considered a team for each level of competition.
- A horse/rider combination may not repeat as champion at the same level in succeeding years except for Grand Prix.
- All eligible scores should be submitted along with a completed Year-End Awards Recording Form and copies of the front of each test.
- Awards will be presented at the Annual General Meeting Awards Banquet.

JR/YR Multi Organization Award

Purpose:

This award is to promote dressage as a sport along with another horse related member organization (4-H, FFA, Pony Club, Breed organization)

Program Rules:

- Applicant must be a GCC member in good standing on the date the score was awarded.
- Horse must be registered with ODS on the date the score was awarded.
- Horse/rider team must submit a minimum of two (2) scores from a GCC approved schooling show.
- Applicant must demonstrate they are either showing or using the same horse in another member organization project as used to obtain GCC scores.
- All eligible scores should be submitted along with a completed Multi Organization Award Recording Form, proof of other organization participation, and an essay on their experience.
- Winner will be determined based on a combination the median score and their essay.
- Award will be presented at the Annual General Meeting
