



CLSAT Equipment Usage Agreement

Policy

Youth boat ownership is encouraged. However, in order to introduce new sailors to the sport and ensure the youth program fits all budgets, CLSAT owns a limited number of boats that may be leased seasonally.

The single-handed boats are available for seasonal use to club members. New sailors who are trying out the program as well as sailors who might otherwise be prohibited from sailing for financial reasons will be given the first option to rent the CLSAT owned boats. Returning sailors are encouraged to purchase their own boats.

In addition to the single-handed boats, CLSAT owns five 420's. Sailors participating in the 420 track at camp will be charged a rental fee. Approved sailors may race the 420's on the CLSA adult course and the I-LYA Traveler Series.

Terms

- Sailors are responsible for the boat and all the parts.
- Boats are to remain at CLSA with the exception of I-LYA Traveler Series events. For events outside of the I-LYA Traveler Series, permission from CLSAT is required.
- The State of Ohio requires that all boats stored by the water pay a yearly fee. This responsibility will be assumed by the Leasing family.
- Boats must be stored in designated CLSAT racks or on dollies.
- For a full deposit refund, the boat, parts and completed inventory check list are to be returned to the junior container by October 15. Boats must be freshly washed. Families who use CLSAT equipment are expected to help pack the container at a to be determined fall date.
- Adult family members are required to fulfill RC duty on the youth course
