On December 8th the Delaware Valley Bicycle Club's Board of Directors voted 6-2-1 in favor of supporting the Blue Route Bikeway/Walkway. DVBC's support initially is a check for \$100 to the "Blue Route Bikeway/Walkway". Our long term commitment is a pledge to eventually raise \$1000 for the "Blue Route Bikeway/Walkway".
