# AYC VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES



There are a number of activities where membership involvement is crucial for the Anacortes Yacht Club to continue being successful and satisfying to you, a member. Keep this page as a reference for use as a member of AYC.

- **Leadership.** Work with Flag Officers and Board of Directors to make sure AYC is run smoothly and to the benefit of all members. Leadership areas where your expertise would be welcome are:
  - Government Affairs - Port & City of Anacortes
  - RBAW - Recreational Boating Association of Washington
  - Communications (Annual AYC Roster, "Knot News Monthly Newsletter", Publicity, Photography)
  - Strategic and Long-Range Planning
- **Bartending.** One of the best ways to meet other club members. Prior to becoming a bartender, you must complete the online "Mandatory Alcohol Server Training" (MAST) class. Once completed the State of Washington will issue you a license. Our Rear Commodore will conduct training on how to operate the bar at the club.
- **Galley Operations.** Catered meals are served at our monthly "General Meetings" and help is needed to serve and clean up after the event. Volunteer with one or two other couples to sponsor a "\$5 Dinner Night" typically held the last Friday of each month. Our Vice Commodore is responsible for the kitchen and food events.
- **Facilities.** We own our clubhouse and are responsible for its upkeep. Our Facilities Director and Rear Commodore coordinate activities to upgrade our building and grounds. Help in this area is always appreciated.
- **Membership.** Assist Membership Chair to attract new members and to help new members get acquainted with activities at the club.
- **Finance/Accounting.** Help with financial aspects of operating our club.
- **Technology.** AYC uses club management software to orchestrate events, communications to members, and volunteering at the club. A weekly "Action Alert" describing upcoming events is sent to all members each Monday. The monthly "Knot News" covers AYC activities from the previous month. Both publications rely on the input from members for content.
- **Racing & "Sail/Regatta Committee".** AYC sponsors Wednesday night racing (March – September) and long-distance races. The "Sail/Regatta Committee" needs assistance in operating our two invitational long-distance races and the Windermere Regatta.
- **Cruising.** Whether you are a power boater or sailor plan to participate in our numerous rendezvous style cruise events taking place throughout the year.
- **Reciprocal Dock.** AYC has moorage available for boats visiting the Cap Sante Marina from other yacht clubs. Visitors can find moorage and registration information in the kiosk located next to the "AYC Reciprocal Dock". NOTE: The "AYC Reciprocal Dock" is not to be used by AYC members, however, we do have reciprocal mooring privileges at other yacht clubs in the area.
- **Special Events.** Lots of fun and memorable times including:
  - Opening Day of Boating Season & Boat Parade (First Saturday of May).
  - Annual Anacortes Waterfront Festival (First Weekend in June). Free boat rides are offered by club members followed by a BBQ on Sunday.
  - Anacortes Boat Show. Participate in this springtime event sponsored by the Anacortes Chamber of Commerce.
  - City of Anacortes "Fourth of July Parade" and evening fireworks
  - Anacortes High School Sailing Team instruction
- **Youth Sailing.** AYC is a contributor to the "Anacortes High School Sailing Team". We provide financial and assistance to the team and support the various regattas held on Fidalgo Bay. At this time, the operation and training of the team is coordinated through the Anacortes Waterfront Alliance.
