



ELECTION CALENDAR 2019

(Excerpt from Secretary of State's Calendar)

August

- 5 Last day to file an initiative petition with the Secretary of State for 2019 election.
- 30 Last day for candidates for local school boards to file a nomination petition.

September

- 6 Last day for local election officials (city, school district, etc.) to certify content for the ballot and deliver it to the county clerk for a coordinated election.
- 20 Last day to submit pro/con statements pertaining to local ballot issues to local election official to be included in the ballot notice mailed to registered electors in a household.
- 21 Deadline to send mail ballots to military and overseas electors.
First day a county clerk may issue a ballot to a voter who requests one in person.

October

- 4 Last day to mail notice of election for ballot issues.
- 15 Last day to submit an application to register to vote through a voter registration drive (VRD) to county clerks. (22 days before election)
- 11 First day mail ballots may be sent to voters except for UOCAVA.
- 21 Counting of mail ballots may begin. No results may be disclosed until after 7:00 pm on Election Day,
- 28 Last day to submit a voter registration application in the mail, online, voter registration agency or DMV to receive a ballot in the mail.
- 28 First day Voter Service and Polling Centers (VSPC's) must be open – at least 8 days before and on Election Day (except Sunday).
- 29 First day drop-off locations must be open (7 days before Election Day including Saturdays and Sundays).

November

- 5 **Coordinated Election – Polls open 7:00 am – 7:00 pm.** Ballots must be received no later than 7:00 pm to be counted. Ballots cast by overseas and military voters must be sent by 7:00 pm. Same Day Voter Registration available at VSPC's.
- 13 Ballots from military and overseas voters must be received no later than close of business. (The 8th day after the election).
- 15 Last day for voter to cure any signature discrepancy, missing signature, or missing ID.

December

- 9 Last day for a Presidential Primary candidate to file to file petition to be on the **March 3 Presidential Primary Election.** (No later than 85 days before election.)
