



Thomas G. Giolas, Ph.D., Memorial Scholarship

The Thomas G. Giolas, Ph.D., Memorial Scholarship has been established to recognize a Doctor of Audiology student who best embodies the spirit, leadership, guidance, commitment, and educational standards that Dr. Giolas exemplified during his many years as a clinician, professor, Chair Person and Dean of Graduate students at the University of Connecticut.

The \$1500.00 scholarship will be presented at the Connecticut Academy of Audiology's annual convention in the spring of each year. While there are no restrictions on how the money is to be spent, the intent is for it to be used toward education. All requested information must be received no later than April 1st by the Connecticut Academy of Audiology's scholarship committee.

Guidelines for Application – to be eligible the student must meet the following criteria:

- 1) be a resident of the State of Connecticut (copy of driver's license required if attending a doctoral program out of state) or attending an audiology doctoral program in the state of Connecticut
- 2) be enrolled in a four year Doctor of Audiology program
- 3) be a 2nd year student in a Doctor of Audiology program
- 4) be a full-time student
- 5) Submit two letters of recommendation that describe clinical and academic abilities. These letters may be from faculty members or supervisors of practicum.
- 6) Submit a completed application form along with a transcript of all graduate coursework.
