

2021 Chipping Program

Stack your piles --every pile counts!

We encourage you to create and maintain defensible space on your Serene Lakes property. Having piles of tree limbs, dead or unhealthy trees around the community provides fuel for a fire. We ask all homeowners to complete their defensible space work and register their pile no later than August 8

If you plan to participate in the free 2021 SLPOA/Truckee Fire Sponsored Chipping Program, **piles must meet specific requirements and must be registered no later than August 8, 2021.**

Placer County will be doing the chipping at Serene Lakes this summer and will only chip your pile if you are registered no later than the August 8th deadline. Space is limited so participation is on a "first come first serve" basis. This year SLPOA and Truckee Fire have allocated \$17,000 (\$12,000 SLPOA and \$5,000 Truckee Fire) toward chipping in our community.

Here is what you need to know and do

Assess the work that needs to be done on your property. If it is extensive or does not meet specific program requirements, contact a tree service (see our recommended partners on the website.)

Schedule & Complete your work - Whether you are hiring a tree service or intend to participate the SLPOA /Truckee Fire Chipping Program, doing the work early in the season will be beneficial to our community in creating/maintaining defensible space and space will fill up quickly. If your defensible space work doesn't qualify for the free chipping program, then the tree services you hire must also chip and spread or remove your cuttings.

Signup for Chipping - Before registering your pile for chipping review the qualifications.

Qualifications for Free Chipping Program

Stack your pile on your property neatly with all trunks facing perpendicular to the street

Size of piles should be no larger than a VW Beetle Bug (small car) **14' Wide x 6'Deep x 5' High AND tree limbs must be less than 8" in diameter.**

DO NOT leave a "birds nest" of a pile (rocks and raked little twigs can damage the chipper). Placer County will NOT chip if you leave a birds nest and you will need to remove it by other means at your own expense.
