# Viva Village Membership Information



## ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

- Support of Viva Village, ensuring it will be a lasting presence in our community
- Full participation in our Village community, all programs, events, and access to our screened vendor list
- If needed, upgrade to one month of full-service membership in case of an emergency
- Two introductory volunteer service appointments
- \$300 per year for single person in a home; \$200 per year for each additional person in that home requesting membership
- Portion of fee may be tax deductible, as allowed by law

## FULL SERVICE MEMBERSHIP

- Full participation in our Village community, all programs, volunteer services, and access to our screened vendor list
- Services by vetted and trained volunteers: chores and lighthousehold help, yard and garden help, transportation, technology support
- \$540 per year for single person in a home; \$240 per year for each additional person in that home requesting membership
- Not tax deductible

- ✓ Membership is an annual contract, renewable yearly.
- ✓ Membership fees are payable annually by check or credit card, or monthly by automatic bank withdrawal (ACH).
- ✓ Membership fee assistance may be available to those who qualify.
