

## Daniel B. Goldstein



Daniel B. Goldstein, age 85, of Newtonville, died on Saturday, July 9, 2011 at the Daughters of Sarah Nursing Center. Born in Brooklyn, N.Y., Dan was a graduate of Adelphi University. He moved to Albany 46 years ago. He was an accountant and specialized in real estate. He had been employed by Albert and Kirsch in Albany, the State Facility Development Corporation and later was employed by Uccullini Real Estate Company. Dan was a Navy veteran having served in World War II as well as Korea. He was a member of Congregation Beth Emeth in Albany, the Saratoga Sailing Club where he had also served as treasurer, and was past president and member of the board of directors of the B'nai B'rith Parkview Apartments in Albany. In later years Dan volunteered his time tutoring 4th grade students at School # 19 in Albany; ultimately they made him an honorary member of the PTA. Dan loved people and people loved him.
