28	1945, #C133 overprint of the National Palace, one with double overprint and inverted.	20
29	1945 (#310) 0.5c Ruins of Zakuleu - Full Sheet of 40 - Fresh, Never Hinged Stamps. A beautiful Sheet.	20
30	1922 Issue with 25c Surcharge, Scott #192-201, all five types (V-IX) with 50 stamps total. Mint condition. Most stamps are light hinged, a few Never Hinged, and only 2 stamps without gum. Total Scott Catalog Value of around \$170.00. A difficult group to assemble!	50

35	1937 Airmail Issue, #C70-79. Complete mint set, both hinged and never hinged stamps. Nice, fresh appearing stamps. Airplane overprint in blue.	20
36	1937 President Ubico Set #280-291. Nice, fresh appearing stamps. A tough set to complete!	40
37	1937 Airmail Issue, #C80-91. Complete mint set, both hinged and never hinged stamps. Nice, fresh appearing stamps. Airplane overprint in black.	20
