103	1871 -- #2b The 5c Light Bistre Brown – Block of four from the upper right section of the sheet. TETE-BECHE pair in upper corner. Hinge remnent on left side. No gum. Small nick out of top of selvage. Catalog \$350+	50
104	1873 -- #5 and #6, used with authentication signatures and marks on the back. Catalog \$390	30
105	1878 – Indian Woman Issue – with four used blocks of 4, an imperf pair, and 4 additional stamps. Somewhere there might be an authentic issue in here, but I doubt it! Assume all are FORGERIES.	20
106	1881 -- #17 and #17a. Block of 4 of the 1c overprint on the 1/4r Brown and Green. Previously hinged, no gum. AND a single with overprint error of ‘ECNTAVO” - unused, previously hinged, no gum. Catalog: \$185 for both items.	20
107	1911 -- #142 – Block of 6 punched SPECIMEN. Appears to be never hinged. 5P Red and Black, President Manuel Cabrera. Nice, fresh-looking stamps. A beautiful multiple!	20
108	1921 -- #177 – 12.5c Surcharge on 25c Green – Block of 10 with three distinct settings. A few tropical stains on back and short perfs on top. A fresh-looking multiple and hard to find.	20
109	1942 - #302-303 – Two blocks of 6, mint never hinged multiples, punched and overprinted SPECIMEN in red. Nice looking stamps. Issued to promote the coffee of Guatemala.	20
110	1967 -- C376-80 – Five blocks of 6, mint never hinged, from the corner of the sheet. Overprinted to commemorate the 8th Central American Boy Scout Camporee. Hard to find multiples of this issue!	20
111	General Stamp Collection of older issues. Between #97 and #116. One page full of older stamp, including two inverted overprints. Nice variety of cancels and different shades.	20
112	Collection of Twenty-Five (25) mint stamps. Most are never hinged, including multiples. Nice, fresh-looking material. SEE BOTH SCANS.	20
113	General Stamp Collection on two pages – SEE BOTH SCANS! Mint and used stamps, almost all the mint stamps are never hinged, including complete sets. Well worth the minimum bid!	20
