T-Shirt size guaranteed for entries post marked before April 1st
Optional advanced sections for experienced riders and the TEETER TOTTER

Bike must be street legal - THERE WILL BE A TECH INSPECTION!
A valid U.S. Forest Service approved spark arrestor is required.
All riders must be licensed and wear helmet, eye protection and boots.
