

KIHEI CANOE CLUB PADDLING AND CLUB USE

COVID-19 RULES

Who can paddle

- Only members of Kihei Canoe Club may paddle. No Guests, relatives, visitors, or members of other canoe clubs are permitted.
- Participation is voluntary. Individuals who are sick, exhibiting any symptoms, or have been exposed to anyone who is ill, COVID-19 positive, or to any traveler who has not completed their 14-day quarantine shall not be allowed to participate for 14 days from the date of exposure.

Contact Tracing

- Paddlers MUST register on the Club's website Event Calendar for each paddling session they wish to participate in. No registration, no paddle.
- Steersmen must complete and file a crew datasheet for each paddling session

Hygiene

- Before and after paddling, all members should wash their hands or use personal hand sanitizer.
- Disinfect all easily touched surface on canoe to be used before each paddling session. This includes - bailers, rigging ropes, gunnels, seats (top/bottom), iakos (top/bottom), tops of manu's.
- Paddles and other personal items should not be shared.
- If needed, club paddles must be disinfected prior to use.
- Gloves and masks are encouraged, but not required.

Social Distancing

- Crew bubbles are encouraged such that when crews are established, paddlers stay within their crew to limit potential exposure to other club members.
- Members of a crew should maintain 6' social distance from members of other crews or persons unknown at the club.
- To the extent possible, crew members should not switch to another crew.

Operations

- OC6 and OC12 canoes may be used
- Rollers must be used to move canoes from parking to launch and return. Use of 2 rollers is recommended.
- PFD's are required for all paddlers during non-racing events
- Paddling may occur only during times posted on the Club Event Calendar on line. Special paddling times may be requested by contacting the club.
- Up to 5 crews (30 members) may gather to paddle in the same time slot.
- Coaching limited to one crew at a time.
- Workouts available electronically or on bulletin board.

Club Facilities

- Canoe club facilities or hales may be used for non-essential events or other social gatherings of up to 5 groups of 10 members (50 total members)
- Tank must be disinfected before use using method outlined in Hygiene section
