

## Call for Applications – Scholarship Information Guide

The Philadelphia Engineering Foundation, in conjunction with the Delaware Valley Engineers Week Committee of the Engineers' Club of Philadelphia, administers five types of scholarships. This Guide provides information on all five, which use a common application form.

You may apply for more than one scholarship; however separate applications **MUST** be submitted for each scholarship.

### SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTIONS AND CRITERIA

The Delaware Valley Engineers Week / American Society of Civil Engineers Scholarship is funded by the Philadelphia Section of ASCE. The remaining scholarships are financed by contributions from the engineering community or endowments administered by the Philadelphia Engineering Foundation.

#### Delaware Valley Engineers Week Scholarships

Delaware Valley Engineers Week (DVEW) Scholarships are awarded in two categories:

- DVEW Undergraduate Scholarship (at least two \$2,500 scholarships) for students in a college within the Delaware Valley\* (including community colleges)
- DVEW / American Society of Civil Engineers Scholarship (one \$2,000 scholarship)
  - Incoming junior or senior (including pre-juniors at Drexel) in a college within Delaware Valley\*)
  - Declared major in civil engineering or a related field.

The applications will be evaluated on these criteria

#### Lewis A. Caccese Scholarship

For 2019, \$3,000 is available for one or more scholarships to be awarded to engineering students from one of the Delaware Valley\* accredited engineering schools who:

- have earned at least 25% of the credits required for an engineering degree
- have maintained a GPA of at least 3.0
- have engaged in extracurricular professional and community activities
- are recommended by the Dean of Engineering

Engineers Week was established to help increase public understanding of the engineering profession. Delaware Valley Engineers Week (DVEW) is sponsored by a coalition of engineering societies, government agencies, universities and major corporations representing thousands of engineers. \*Delaware Valley is defined as Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties in Pennsylvania and Burlington, Camden, Gloucester, Mercer and Salem counties in Southern New Jersey.

### Pennoni / John Morrison Memorial Scholarship

Pennoni Associates, Inc. annually awards the Pennoni / John Morrison Memorial Scholarship to a civil engineering student from one of the Delaware Valley\* accredited engineering schools. For 2019, \$1,750 will be available for award to a civil engineering student who:

- has earned at least 50% of the credits required for a civil engineering degree
- has maintained a GPA of at least 3.0
- has indicated financial need
- has engaged in extracurricular professional and community activities
- is recommended by the Dean of Engineering

### Walter G. Neal, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

The Walter G. Neal, Jr. Memorial Scholarship is available only to Engineers' Club members in good standing and their immediate families (spouse or children) for engineering-related courses. "Member" includes any employee of a corporate member, contingent upon being an employee at the time the application is submitted. For 2019, \$2,500 is available for one or more scholarships to be used for tuition and direct education expenses for:

- undergraduate or graduate courses leading to a degree,
- preparation for professional certification, or
- specialized courses and seminars to bring practicing engineers up-to-date on latest techniques and new areas of engineering.

- **Transcript:** Official copy of transcript.
- **Recommendation** (if required by the scholarship for which you are applying):
  - Letter of recommendation by a professor or job supervisor {required for the DVEW and DVEW/ASCE Scholarships}
  - Letter of recommendation by the Engineering Dean {required for Caccese and Pennoni / Morrison Scholarships}
- **Proof of Enrollment:** Attach a copy of your tuition receipt, current registration card, or course registration.
- **Financial Need:** Demonstration of financial need {required for Pennoni / Morrison Scholarship}
