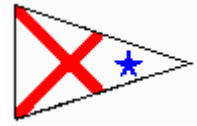


SAILING INSTRUCTIONS ENSIGN NELSON TROPHY



Hosted by Island Heights Yacht Club
Saturday July 23, 2011

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by completing an entry form on-site and paying the entry fee to Island Heights Yacht Club before 10:15am on Saturday July 23, 2011.

3. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located adjacent to the Commodore's Room.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located on the south side (rear) of IHYC. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than one hour (1 hr) after the AP is lowered.

5. SCHEDULE

A competitors' meeting will be held at 10:30am on Saturday July 23, 2011 on the south side (rear) of the IHYC. The warning signal for the first race will be at 12:00pm that same day. Subsequent races will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race. Three (3) races are planned.

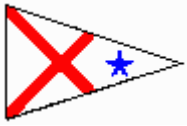
6. CLASS FLAGS

7. RACING AREA

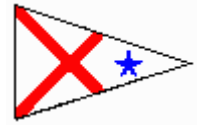

8. COURSES AND MARKS

The attached diagram shows the course, the marks in order, and the rounding direction of each mark. The windward and leeward marks will be yellow, round buoys. The offset mark will be a round buoy.

All courses will be windward-leeward, finish to leeward. All marks will be rounded to port. A windward off-set must be honored at each windward mark rounding. A placard will be displayed off the rear of the starting boat with a "1", "2" or "3" indicating the number of windward mark roundings for each race.

9. PENALTIES

Double-Turn Penalty.

10. STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The starting and finishing lines will be between the orange flag on the signal boat and a round buoy placed to port.

11. TIME LIMIT

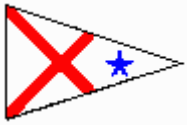
The time limit for each race will be one hour (1 hr) for the first boat to finish. Boats finishing more than twenty minutes (20 min) after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, 36.1, A4 and A5.

12. PROTESTS

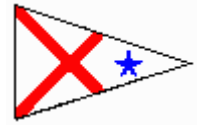
Protests shall be delivered to the official notice board area within sixty minutes (60 min) after the race committee finish boat docks. The protest time limit and list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as possible.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee will communicate on VHF 69. The RC will make an effort to call each boat involved in an individual recall, but is not obligated to do so.

14. SCORING

The low point scoring system will be used. All scores will count. This changes RRS A2.

15. TROPHIES

Awards will be presented to the top three finishers (participation allowing).
The winner will be presented the Gordon M. Nelson Memorial Trophy
